Please read all of the following auction rules. If you have any questions, ask a staff member before signing. We are an auction facilitating a transaction between a buyer and a seller. All sales are FINAL and AS/IS.

- 1. A Cash Deposit of \$500.00 along with this registration form is required of all individuals wanting to bid on vehicles. The person/dealer with the highest bid on a vehicle sells as-is, all sales are final. If you buy a vehicle, the deposit will go towards the purchase, and the balance must be paid in full before the vehicle is taken off the property. Although partial payments are taken on the day of sale (Saturday), you must pay the vehicle in full by 4pm Monday. If you do not purchase a vehicle the deposit will be returned to you only, after returning your bidder badge and receipt. No deposits will be returned or transferred to a purchase of a vehicle without the return of the original receipt.
- 2. BIDDING ON A VEHICLE IS ENTERING INTO A CONTRACT TO PURCHASING THE VEHICLE.
- 3. Frame damage, title issues or odometer problems must be reported within 72 hours of sale. (Green light only)
- 4. TITLE ATTACHED (BLUE LIGHT) means the title has not been turned in and the seller has 45 days to turn in the title to auction. If the vehicle is sold TITLE ATTACHED the auction does not guarantee the title and the vehicle may be returned. If the seller cannot turn in the title, then you can return the vehicle in the same condition you purchased it and your payment will be refunded in full for the purchase price only.

THE AUCTION IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR MONEY SPENT ON VEHICLES ON TITLE ATTACHED (TITLE DELAY) TRANSACTIONS.

- 5. No one under the age of 16 is allowed in the auction lot or in the auction area.
- 6. Be sure you are aware of which vehicle you are bidding on, as vehicles often leave before the final bid. The auction is not responsible for your misunderstanding of what vehicle you are bidding on. If you are unsure, ask the auctioneer.

I have read and understand all the rules and regulations stated above. I also understand that by me not following the rules and regulations stated above or any posted Auction rules could result in the forfeit of my deposit.
